Part 2

John 19: 25-27 NLT

25 Standing near the cross were Jesus' mother, and his mother's sister, Mary (the wife of Clopas), and Mary Magdalene. 26 When Jesus saw his mother standing there beside the disciple he loved, he said to her, "Dear woman, here is your son." 27 And he said to this disciple, "Here is your mother." And from then on this disciple took her into his home.

John 19: 25-27 NLT

1) Protect your mother

²⁵ Standing near the cross were Jesus' mother, and his mother's sister, Mary (the wife of Clopas), and Mary Magdalene. ²⁶ When Jesus saw his mother standing there beside the disciple he loved, he said to her, "Dear woman, here is your son." ²⁷ And he said to this disciple, "Here is your mother." And from then on this disciple took her into his home.

Proverbs 1: 8-9 NLT

2) Pay attention to your mother

⁸ My child, listen when your father corrects you. <u>Don't neglect your mother's instruction</u>. ⁹ What you learn from them will crown you with grace and be a chain of honor around your neck.

Ephesians 6: 1-3 NLT

3) Purposely honor your mother

Children, obey your parents because you belong to the Lord, for this is the right thing to do. ² "Honor your father and mother." This is the first commandment with a promise: ³ If you honor your father and mother, "things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth."

Ephesians 5: 25-27 NLT

4) Present your wife spotless

²⁵ For husbands, this means <u>love your wives, just as</u>
<u>Christ loved the church</u>. He gave up his life for her ²⁶ to make her <u>holy</u> and <u>clean</u>, <u>washed by the cleansing of</u>
<u>God's word</u>. ²⁷ He did this <u>to present her to himself</u> as a <u>glorious</u> church <u>without a spot or wrinkle or any other</u>
<u>blemish</u>. Instead, <u>she will be holy and without fault</u>.

Ephesians 5: 28-30 NLT

5) Produce healthiness in, on, and around your wife

²⁸ In the same way, <u>husbands ought to love their wives</u> as they love their own bodies. For a man who loves his wife actually shows love for himself. ²⁹ No one hates his own body but feeds and cares for it, just as Christ cares for the church.
