<sup>34</sup> But when the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees with his reply, they met together to question him again. <sup>35</sup> One of them, an expert in religious law, tried to trap him with this question: <sup>36</sup> "Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?"



# Part 2: Love is the Answer

#### Matthew 22: 37-38 NLT

1) Love the Lord with your all

<sup>37</sup> Jesus replied, "<u>You must love the LORD your God</u> with <u>all your heart</u>, <u>all your soul</u>, and <u>all your mind</u>.' <sup>38</sup> This is <u>the first and greatest commandment</u>.

#### Matthew 22: 39 NLT

2) Love your neighbor as yourself

<sup>39</sup> A second is equally important: <u>'Love your neighbor</u> <u>as yourself</u>.'

#### Matthew 22: 37-40 NLT

3) Love sets us free

<sup>37</sup> Jesus replied, "You must love the LORD your God with <u>all your heart</u>, <u>all your soul</u>, and <u>all your mind</u>." <sup>38</sup> This is <u>the first and greatest commandment</u>. <sup>39</sup> A second is equally important: '<u>Love your neighbor as</u> <u>yourself</u>.' <sup>40</sup> The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."
